




The Career Tree is used today in high schools, middle schools, K–12 districts, career centers, special needs classrooms, technical and community colleges, universities, workforce development settings, adult education centers, and many others across North America.

In this example, the Biotechnology Program is the trunk that leads to the top of the Tree, where every branch represents a career or occupation. Every Career Tree is unique, customized with the 36 career pathways that you determine are the most engaging and viable in your region.

- Students can unlock the opportunities in the first set of branches by completing their current program or course of study.
- Students can unlock the next level by pursuing additional education such as an associate's degree, advanced certification, or apprenticeship.
- And if they push their education even further with a fouryear or master's degree or PhD, they can unlock the third level. Work experience in the field may also equip an individual for another level.





After meaningful research, class dialogue, and self-reflection, students write their name and career goal on a Career Leaf Label and affix it to the Career Tree in their learning environment. It then becomes a powerful visual reminder, every day, of why today's learning matters to that end-game goal.

The Career Tree also features a robust Root System of Academics, Experiences, Professional Skills, and Passion—all crucial areas that young people need to develop in order to ascend the Tree and reach their desired career branch.

The Career Tree comes with a range of valuable classroom tools, available electronically or printed, to deepen the conversation:

- **The Compare & Contrast sheet** helps students research careers and lifestyles as they start envisioning their branches.
- **The Branch Report** allows students to dive deeper and structure their class presentations effectively.
- The Root System Career Plan helps students explore the Academics, Experiences, Professional Skills, and Passion they need to reach their desired branch.
- **The Resume Planner** empowers young people to develop substantive and impactful content for their first resumes.

Academic, Middle School, Special Needs, and other specialized Trees are also available to spark valuable conversation and action in these settings.
